To facilitate this transition, the school has collaborated with little chefs to develop innovative and appealing recipes that integrate Millets seamlessly into our meals. Here comes the yummy yummy recipes:*



### PANEER RAGI WRAP

#### Ingredients FOR DOUGH

1 cup Ragi Flour, □ cup Warm Water,  
Salt to taste, □ teaspoon Ghee.

#### FOR PANEER FILLING

1 teaspoon Oil, 1 cup small cubes Paneer, Red Chilli Powder, Salt, Paneer Tikka Masala.

#### FOR MINT CHUTNEY

□ cup coriander leaves, □ cup mint leaves, 2 green chillies, Juice of 1 lime, Salt to taste.

#### RECIPE

- ✓ In a bowl mix flour and salt. Add □ cup warm water and gently mix. Then knead the dough by sprinkling water bit by bit until you get a soft dough. Spread 1/6 teaspoon ghee on the dough and cover. Let the dough rest for around 10-15 minutes.
- ✓ Heat the oil in a pan and add the paneer pieces. Next add salt, red chilli powder and paneer tikka masala and mix to coat the paneer pieces with the spices. Sauté the paneer pieces on medium to low heat for 1-2 minutes to lightly colour them. Turn off the heat and keep aside.
- ✓ Prepare coriander mint chutney by grinding together coriander, mint, green chillies, salt and lime juice.
- ✓ Once the dough has rested for at least 15 minutes knead the dough once again and divide it into 7-8 equal portions.
- ✓ Heat a tawa/flat pan and place the rolled wrap on the hot tawa. Spread the ghee on the roti and flip the roti to the other side. When it has golden spots that means it cooked.
- ✓ Take a cooked wrap and spread a teaspoon of mint coriander evenly. Place paneer filling in the middle of the wrap.



### RAGI CHOCOLATE MUG CAKE

#### Ingredients

Ragi Flour, Baking Soda, Milk, Oil, Melted Chocolate, Jaggery Powder, Cocoa Powder, Vanilla Essence.

#### RECIPE

Take a cup and put some ragi flour, jaggery powder, baking soda, cocoa powder and give it mix, then put some milk followed by some oil and some vanilla essence. Now microwave it for 2 minutes and for garnishing put some melted chocolate on it.



### KATORI CHAAT

#### Ingredients

Ragi Flour (1 bowl), Refined Wheat Flour (2 bowl), Black salt, Salt, Black Jeera.

#### RECIPE

Make dough with water, Take some dough and make a shape of katori with a help of a bowl & Fry it.

#### RECIPE FOR SORGHUM SALAD

#### Ingredients

Sorghum (one night before soaked), Different varieties of Capsicum, Corn, Tomato, Onion.

#### RECIPE

- ✓ Soak sorghum one night before.
- ✓ Chop varieties of Capsicum.
- ✓ Then add boiled corn, chopped tomatoes and onion.
- ✓ Now mix them well. Garnish with coriander.
- ✓ Add two spoons of Sorghum salad in a katori & enjoy your healthy snack.

#### Ingredients

The NCrf is a set of guidelines to be followed by schools, colleges and universities in adopting the credit system. The framework, developed by a government committee, allows candidates to earn credits, accumulate, and transfer them for equivalence, enabling multiple entry and exits into the skilling and education ecosystem

\*\*\*Integration of academic and vocational domains to ensure flexibility and mobility between the two.

\*\*\*Mainstreaming of skilling and vocational education by inter-mingling school and higher education with vocational education and experiential learning.

\*\*\*NCrf will also enable students who have dropped out of mainstream education to re-enter the education ecosystem academic assessments from elementary to higher education, including vocational and skill development courses, are eligible for credits, which can be accumulated in the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC).

\*\*\*The framework extends to non-academic activities such as sports, games, yoga, physical activities, performing arts, handicrafts, and bag-less days.

•**Enhanced Flexibility:** The NCF allows students to accumulate credits for courses completed, regardless of the institution or program they are enrolled in.

•**Greater Inclusivity:** It opens up opportunities for individuals from different backgrounds and age groups to access higher education and skills development, thereby reducing barriers to entry and fostering lifelong learning.

•**Quality Assurance:** The NCF creates standards for evaluating and accrediting schools and programs, guaranteeing that high standards are upheld throughout the education industry.

•**Empowerment of Learners:** By placing students at the center of the learning process and empowering them to take ownership of their educational journey, the NCF fosters a culture of self-directed learning and personal development.
